STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN AND SPILL PREVENTION CONTROL AND COUNTERMEASURES PLANS

A major steel manufacturer in Ohio has four main facilities. In addition to many environmental permits, each facility is required to possess and update their Spill Prevention, Control and Countermeasures Plan (SPCC) and the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). EnviroScience revised the SPCC and SWPPP plans for each facility by reviewing the existing plans, evaluating them for applicability and conformance with current applicable state and federal regulations, and performing a site inspection to verify and obtain any additional necessary information. Using the gathered information, EnviroScience created reports in a format that meets the regulations for both the SPCC and SWPPP plans. The project began in December 2014 and was completed August 1, 2015.
